

I. Nutrition, Food Science, and Technology

This domain is centred around the biological necessity of food and its role in health, culture, and industry.

- **Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics:**

- **Roles:** Professionals work as **dietitians**, diet counsellors, or clinical nutritionists. They plan diets for individuals at various life stages, modify diets for disease management, and cater to special groups like athletes or defence personnel.

- **Preparation:** Requires a 10+2 qualification followed by a **B.Sc. in Home Science or Nutrition**. To become a **Registered Dietitian (RD)**, one must complete a Postgraduate Diploma in Dietetics and an internship.

- **Career Avenues:** Speciality departments in hospitals, health clubs, freelance consultancy, and technical writing.

- **Public Nutrition and Health:**

- **Roles:** Community nutritionists focus on promoting health and preventing disease at the population level.

- **Career Avenues:** Positions within government programmes like the **Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS)**, voluntary organisations (UNICEF, NGOs), and as school health counsellors.

- **Food Processing and Technology:**

- **Roles:** This technical field involves transforming raw ingredients into finished, shelf-stable food products. Professionals monitor quality, develop new products (R&D), and manage food safety.

- **Preparation:** Options range from short-term certificate/diploma courses for self-employment to Bachelor's and Master's degrees for research and management roles in large industries.

- **Career Avenues:** Production managers, quality assurance specialists, and sensory evaluators in the beverage, dairy, and confectionery industries.

- **Food Quality and Food Safety:**

- **Roles:** Ensuring the "safety culture" of food manufacturing and catering is critical. Professionals work as food safety officers, auditors, and analysts.

- **Career Avenues: Quality Control Laboratories**, regulatory agencies (BIS, Agmark), and HACCP (Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point) specialists.

II. Human Development and Family Studies (HDFS)

HDFS prepares students to provide meaningful services for people across the lifespan, focusing on interpersonal relationships and group dynamics.

- **Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE):**

- **Roles:** Educators provide stimulating learning experiences for young

children before they enter formal schooling.

- **Preparation:** Requires an undergraduate degree in Child Development or Psychology. Nursery Teacher Training (NTT) or one-year diplomas are also entry points.

- **Career Avenues:** Teachers in nursery schools, caregivers in crèches or day care centres, and entrepreneurs in child-related activity clubs.

- **Management of Support Services for Vulnerable Groups:**

- **Roles:** This involves managing institutions and programmes for children, youth, and the elderly. It requires strong **people skills** and the ability to build linkages with the community.

- **Career Avenues:** Managers in children's homes, **NGO management**, and functionaries in youth development programmes or senior citizen homes.

- **Career Avenues:** Textile designers for industries or fashion houses, freelancers, and specialists in furnishing.

- **Fashion Design and Merchandising:**

- **Roles:** This dynamic field combines artistic talent with business acumen. Merchandisers focus on the trade and commercial aspects of fashion.

- **Preparation:** 4-year Bachelor's degrees combine liberal arts with business and fashion courses.

- **Career Avenues:** Interior designing, visual merchandising (merchandise displays), and costume design for theatre sets.

- **Production and Quality Control:**

- **Roles:** Focuses on the mass production of garments and ensuring they meet technical standards.

- **Career Avenues:** Quality control managers and production specialists in the garment export sector.

III. Fabric and Apparel

This creative and technical sector is an important part of the Indian economy.

- **Design for Fabric and Apparel:**

- **Roles:** Designing involves the planning and creation of an article for a specific purpose, ranging from textile properties to fashion trends.

- **Care and Maintenance of Fabrics:**

- **Roles:** This technical field deals with the cleaning and serviceability of textiles in various institutions.

- **Career Avenues:** Managers in hi-tech laundries for **airways, shipping lines, hotels, and hospitals**.



IV. Resource Management

Resource management focuses on the efficient utilisation of human and non-human resources to achieve personal or organisational goals.

- **Hospitality Management:**
 - **Roles:** Rooted in "Athithi Devo Bhava", this field involves providing high-quality service in paid hospitality settings.
 - **Career Avenues:** Positions in the **Front Office** (reception, guest relations), Housekeeping (maintaining aesthetics and hygiene), and the Food and Beverages department.
- **Interior and Landscape Design:**
 - **Roles:** Professionals design user-friendly and attractive indoor and outdoor spaces.
 - **Career Avenues:** Interior designers for private or commercial projects and

landscape designers for public parks and green zones.

- **Event Management:**
 - **Roles:** A speciality profession involving the planning and execution of varied events like product launches, weddings, and conferences.
 - **Career Avenues:** Event coordinators and theme-based event specialists.
- **Consumer Services:**
 - **Roles:** Professionals help sort out consumer problems and provide guidance.
 - **Preparation:** Degrees include B.Sc. in **Family Resource Management** or Resource Management.
 - **Career Avenues:** Working in government bodies like the **Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS)**, voluntary consumer organisations, or corporate customer relationship management.

V. Communication and Extension

This discipline focuses on using media and communication to educate and empower society, particularly the rural population.

- **Development Communication and Journalism (DCJ):**
 - **Roles:** DCJ professionals write with passion and sensitivity about issues like poverty, health, and gender equity to facilitate social change.

- **Career Avenues:** Development journalists for print, TV, or radio, and anchors/radio jockeys for **community radio**.
- **Corporate Communication and Public Relations (PR):**
 - **Roles:** PR officers manage communication between an employer and employees, as well as with external stakeholders like the media and government.
 - **Career Avenues:** PR officers in corporate houses, consultants for school/college clubs, and content developers for consumer awareness advertisements.

1. **Communication:** Applying writing, speaking, and listening skills precisely.
2. **Productivity:** Developing effective work habits, dynamism, and a sense of belonging to the organisation.
3. **Cooperation:** Working with others to solve problems and resolve conflicts.
4. **Critical and Creative Thinking:** Applying analytical strategies and being innovative.
5. **Lifelong Learning:** The motivation to update knowledge and keep pace with advances in one's field.
6. **Negotiation:** The ability to trade concessions and resolve unacceptable points in a deal.
7. **Self-Employment and Entrepreneurship:** For many, the ultimate career goal is to start an enterprise by taking calculated risks to convert novel ideas into reality.
